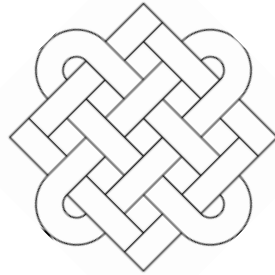

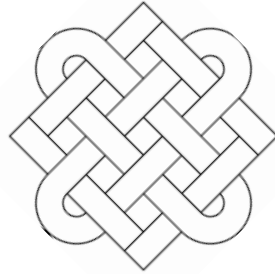

THE NECESSITY OF WELL-ESTABLISHED NATIONAL EMPLOYMENT POLICIES

Introduction: A national employment policy is a comprehensive plan for achieving a country's employment and economic goals. Since employment challenges are getting more and more complex, a well-established employment policy is essential in a society.

- demographic trends
 - First of all, in my opinion, demographic changes like an ageing population and urbanisation are putting enormous pressure on labour markets. Do you agree?
- wage inequality
 - Also, as the wage gap is increasing, certain workers benefit less from economic growth and generate an even wider gap, don't they?
- academic education vs employable skills
 - Don't you think the emphasis on academic education contributes to the lack of skilled workers and therefore employability challenges?
- informal employment
